McCormick states that she will be digging down further for discharge issues and will be requesting a walk through. Skarban states that Saputo has always been very cooperative in the past. Sherman reminds Committee that the people that handle this are no longer part of the local team and are being handled at a higher corporate level outside of the local area.

5. Hazardous Material Response Team

Chief Heckel states radio is received but there are pieces that go with the radio that haven't been received, such as microphone and battery. May 13, 2023 there will be a HAZ-mat refresher onsite at Chem Design. Skarban hoping that there is a hands on again this coming spring/summer.

6. Hazardous Material Clean Up –

McCormick reports there were no call outs for Oconto County this year to date.

5. Informational Items (No Action to Be Taken)

- Aubry reports Spice will be out due to medical issue and to contact her if anything is needed over the next week or so. Troy Sherman is also Spice's backup regarding spills.
