Called to order at 9:03 A.M.

1. Approval of Agenda

Motion by Scanlan/Schneider to approve the agenda. The motion was voted on and carried.

2. Introduction and Purpose of Hearing

Chair Cole called for introductions of committee members, Ken Dolata, County Soil Conservationist, and Kim Pytleski, County Clerk. Ken Dolata, County Conservationist, reviewed the process of forming a lake district. Bob Wittmann presented how the petition process began.

3. Public Hearing: Formation of an Inland Lake, Protection, & Rehabilitation District for White Potato Lake in the Town of Brazeau, WI

Chair Cole opened the public hearing to hear testimony. Kim Pytleski, County Clerk, read six communications (Communications are on file with the Office of the County Clerk). Dolata then read the names from the Public Hearing Appearance Cards (PHAC) and those wishing to speak were given the floor for three minutes each. After reading from 73 cards, Chair Cole asked if there were any others wishing to speak. Hearing none, the testimony portion of the public hearing concluded at 10:15 a.m. (Public Hearing Appearance Cards are on file with the Office of the County Clerk.)
