Review the submitted proposals – Both McMahon and Martenson proposals were reviewed and as questions came up Haag was able to help answer them and understand the terminology.

All of the pertinent questions will be organized and distributed to our committee in preparation for the interviews.

It was decided that we should create copies of the existing building.

Letters will be created and sent to both companies. Interviews will be April 6<sup>th</sup> 10am and 1pm. This should allow enough time for the Firms to make their presentation and answer the qualifying questions. Our committee will summarize our interviews that day, with final determination to be ready by April 13<sup>th</sup>.

Sheriff's wing update – No added updates were noted.

After our building committee meeting, Haag discussed the plans for Winslow Lake Dam replacement. He has been working with the DNR to create a grant. He has recently learned the DNR only works with Lake Districts or Municipalities. He would like to approach the town to sponsor the grant application for Winslow Lake. To this point the Lake Association has paid some of the engineering invoices. Hogan noted that the town has been the Grant Administrator for the noxious weeds grant in the past. This would need to be approved by the board at a public meeting. Since this was a posted public meeting, Zittlow made a motion to support the Winslow Lake Dam project as the Grant Administrator. Booth seconded this motion, and the motion was approved. Haag will work with Hartman to finish the paperwork and submit the grant application.
