2. AGENDA

Motion (Schindel/Hoyer) to approve the agenda. Motion carried. No negative votes.

3. MINUTES

Motion (Hoyer/Holley) to approve the minutes of the August 4<sup>th</sup> 2023 meeting. Motion carried. No negative votes.

4. PUBLIC HEARING 2024 MAR-OCO LANDFILL BUDGETS

Chairperson Holley entertained a motion to open the public hearing on the 2024 budgets.

Motion (Schreiber/Hoyer) to open the public hearing. Motion carried. No negative votes.

Committee reviewed and discussed the budget before closing the hearing.

Motion (Schreiber/Hoyer) to recommend to the respective County Boards the approval of the Mar-Oco Landfill 2024 Administrative and Operations Budgets and resolutions as presented. Motion carried. No negative votes.

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6. PUBLIC COMMENT

Virtues stated that a Clean Sweep grant has been secured under a joint application between Oconto and Marinette Counties and the Department of Agriculture Trade and Consumer Protection. The event is scheduled to be held May 10<sup>th</sup> & 11<sup>th</sup>, 2024 at two sites in each county. More information will be available at the beginning of 2024.

8. LANDFILL TIPPING FEE FOR SINGLE BAGS OF MUNICIPAL SOLID WASTE

The Committee discussed increasing the disposal fee for single bags of municipal solid waste for 2024. The Committee agreed on a \$1.00/bag increase bringing the disposal fee to \$3.00/bag.

Motion (Schindel/Schreiber) to increase the per bag disposal fee to \$3.00 per bag effective January 1, 2024. Motion carried, no negative votes.

9. LANDFILL OPERATIONS

Klose reported that the fuel injectors on the wheel loader needed replacement and two leachate pumps were repaired/replaced.

10. INVOICES

The August 2023 (\$37,282.95) schedule of paid invoices was distributed for Committee review.
