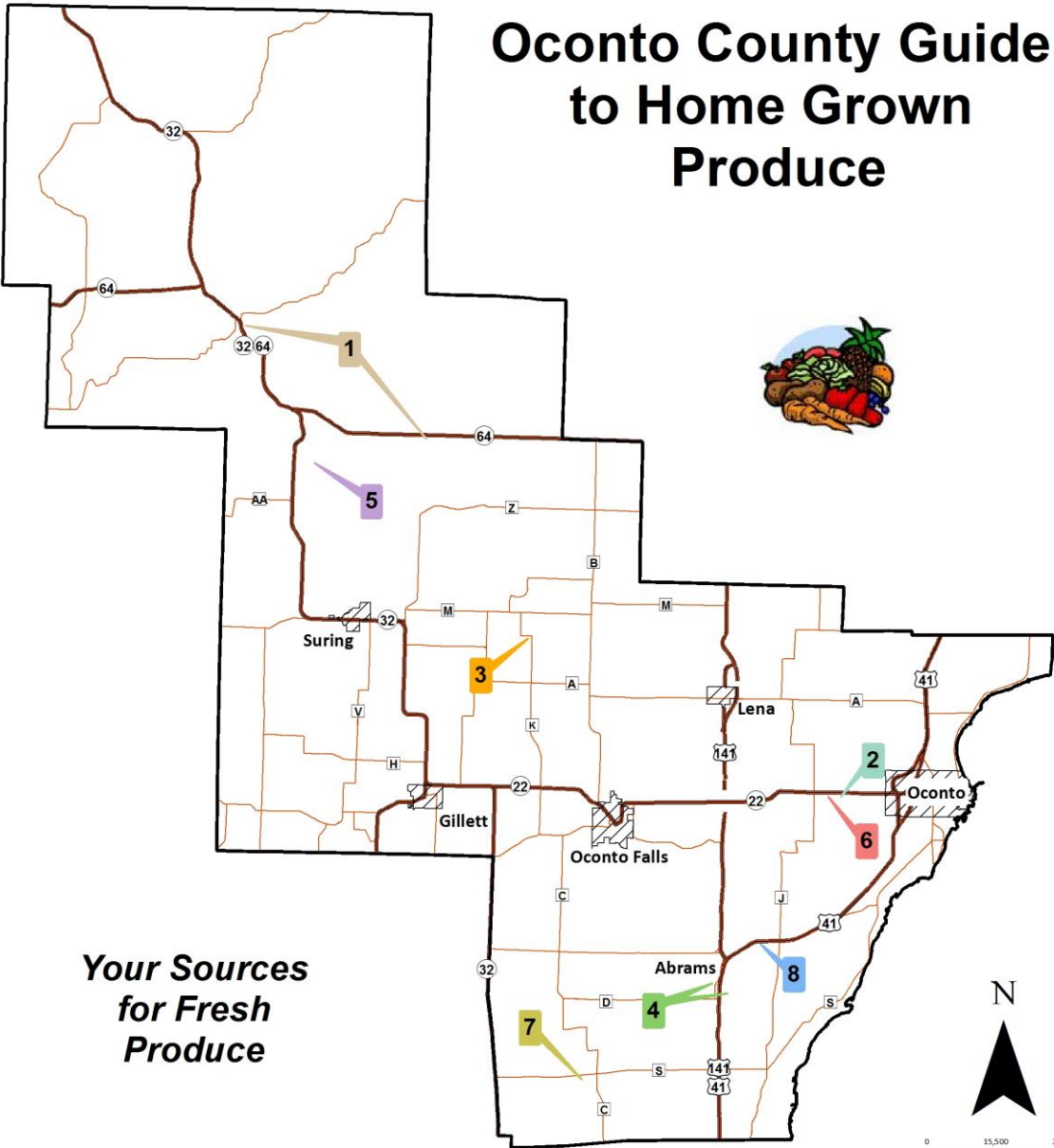

(1) Off Hwy 41-141 take Abrams Exit 185 then go North on the West Frontage Rd (EE) to BerryLand for:

Asparagus- May/June (PYO/picked)

Rhubarb-May/June (PYO/picked)

Strawberries- June/July (PYO/picked 6:30 a.m.-7:30 p.m.)

(2) Off Hwy 41/141 take Abrams Exit 185 then go North on the East Frontage Rd, then left to 5687 Steinkraus Lane, just north of McDonalds at the Farmhouse Ice Cream Parlor for:

Pumpkins- Late September thru October (Mini to Giant, pie and painted)

Open: 9:00 a.m.-5:30 p.m. 7 days a week

Also: Squash, gourds, stalks, bales, decorative corn, fall decorations, ducky derby, face painting, giant bale fort, and other family activities. Child friendly haunted hay rides Saturday & Sunday in October noon-4:00 p.m.
