Chair Konitzer declared a quorum present at 9:30 a.m.

1. Approval of Agenda

Motion by Prellwitz/Bake to approve agenda as amended. The motion was voted on and carried.

2. Approval of Previous Meeting Minutes

Motion by Magnin/Prellwitz to approve the minutes of the January 4, 2021 meeting as presented. The motion was voted on and carried.

4. Public Health COVID update

Konitzer reports 142 positive cases per 100K considered high activity for the past 14 days. County has given out 2200 immunizations through the end of last week. Clinics will be ending, as there are enough options in the nearby community area. Transitioning to homebound/farm-to-farm type vaccine offerings. Coverage is at 35% of our population; with 65 and older over 75%, which are, both lower than the stat of WI as a whole. Discussion followed. Informational only, no formal action taken.

5. Active Shooter Drill

Spice reports working with Sheriff Skarban to create a plan for active shooter drill for the Courthouse complex. Process just getting started. Informational only, no formal action taken.

6. Review Facilities List

Spice questioning if anyone has any questions of the facilities list. Discussion followed. Informational only, no formal action taken.

7. Traffic Incident Management Class

Spice reports there are a lot of new employees at Highway Dept. as well as the Sheriff's office. Spice will be working closely with both departments to get everyone up to speed and make sure procedures are being followed. Manure hauling – not just Oconto County having issues, but is an issue statewide and legislation is in the works for better regulation going forward. Developing local plan. Skarban notes that a better system is needed in order to get compliance. Ideas on anyone working on the road right away would need to apply for an application each year – this would be a combined effort between the Highway Dept. as well as the Sheriff Office. Discussion followed. Safety on the roads is the main concern. Erdman offers to provide samples of plans and applications in use currently with other counties that seem to work well. Private farmers do not need CDL to haul but if contracted out CDL is needed. This issue will be addressed further at a later meeting. Informational only, no formal action taken.

8. 2020 and 2021 Spill Report for Oconto County

Spice reviewed the report. Informational only, no formal action taken.

9. Approve Off-Site Plan (s) and County Wide Strategic Plan

County Wide plan has been submitted and approved. Copies of the Off-Site plans are available by request.

10. Hazardous Material Response Team

Spice looking for any updates. Pennings is working with Bostedt in regards to four personnel from Oconto being are part of the team. Operational refresher was completed. 28 first responders attended the class.

11. Hazardous Material Clean Up

Prellwitz – no updates status quo. 10-5-20 bill still outstanding. Have not been able to contact responsible parties.

- Parmentier – Oconto Falls Ambulance is looking to go full paramedic.
